

**BOROUGH OF SOUTH GREENSBURG
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
SEPTEMBER 13, 2010**

Council President Donald Miller called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

All those present repeated the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

PRESENT: Hixson, Iezzi, Martin, Miller, Yarnell, Zalakar

PRESENT: Mayor Betty Dobies, Solicitor Timothy Fedele, Engineer Douglas Regola

ABSENT: None.

BIDS:

A. 2010 PAVING PROGRAM: Bids for the 2010 Paving Program were received as follows:

A motion was made by Martin/Yarnell to reject all bids. VOTE: 6 Yes, 0 No - Motion carried.

CITIZEN'S REMARKS:

Rose Foschia, 1519 Elm Street

Mrs. Foschia thanked Council for having the bushes and shrubs in her alley cut. She also wanted to know if anything had been done about the parking situation on Jamison Avenue between Poplar and Elm Streets. She said one guy has 6 cars parked everywhere.

Mr. Fedele advised that Council should have the Police check into this.

Mrs. Foschia then suggested putting the monthly police reports on the Borough website. She said too many people in town aren't aware of what's going on.

George Vidakovich, 1920 Adams Street

Mr. Vidakovich thanked Mr. Yarnell and Mr. Martin for cleaning up the town. He also asked them to do something about a trailer down the street from him.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

A. TEAMSTERS CONTRACT: A motion was made by Yarnell/Martin to approve a new 4-year contract with Teamsters Union Local No. 30. VOTE: 6 Yes, 0 No - Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

A. RESOLUTION NO. 2010-05: A motion was made by Zalakar/Martin to adopt Resolution

No. 2010-05, appointing David L. Todaro to Borough Council for an unexpired term ending January 2, 2012. VOTE: 6 Yes, 0 No - Motion carried.

B. SWEARING-IN OF COUNCIL MEMBER: Mr. Todaro was not present at this time.

C. ELECTION OF VICE PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL: A motion was made by Yarnell/Zalakar to elect Clentin C. Martin Vice President of Council. VOTE: 6 Yes, 0 No - Motion carried.

D. APPOINTMENT OF CWCOG REPRESENTATIVE: A motion was made by Iezzi/Martin to appoint Thomas Yarnell as the Borough's representative to the Central Westmoreland Council of Governments. VOTE: 6 Yes, 0 No - Motion carried.

Mr. Todaro entered the meeting at this time and was administered the Oath of Office as Council Member by Mayor Betty Dobies.

E. CLICK-IT-OR-TICKET PROGRAM INSURANCE COVERAGE: Mr. Miller said the Click-It-Or-Ticket Program requires \$1,000,000 auto liability coverage.

Mrs. Iezzi confirmed that the state will accept the Borough's \$500,000 coverage. She also said that the state will reimburse the Borough for wages (not benefits) and that the Borough gets to keep the fines from tickets issued.

A motion was made by Iezzi/Yarnell to authorize the Police Department to participate in the Click-It-Or-Ticket Program. VOTE: 7 Yes, 0 No - Motion carried.

Council President Donald Miller called for an executive session at 7:52 P.M. for legal and personnel matters. The meeting was called back to order at 8:06 P.M.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Iezzi/Hixson to adjourn the meeting. VOTE: 7 Yes, 0 No - Motion carried.
