

**BOROUGH OF SOUTH GREENSBURG
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 11, 2012**

Council President Clentin Martin called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

All those present repeated the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

CITIZEN'S REMARKS:

Ann Bosmay, 1820 Skidmore Drive

Mrs. Bosmay said dirt is piled up near the storm drain on her street and the water runoff is not going into the drain.

Mr. Martin said we need to find out who put the dirt there, because the Borough didn't.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES: A motion was made by Thomas/Iezzi to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on May 14, 2012.

VOTE: 5 Yes, 0 No, 2 Not Present, 0 Abstain - Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE: The Borough Secretary read monthly correspondence and copies were given to each Council member.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

MAYOR: Mayor Dobies presented the Police Report for May: 165 incidents, 81 citations, 9 parking notices, 7 arrests, 2,134 miles logged on the cars and \$2,018.77 collected in fines and reports.

POLICE & EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT: Mrs. Iezzi said Click-It-Or-Ticket ends today.

Mr. Hardy gave his Emergency Management Coordinator's report. He said he would like to see funds available for people who don't have anywhere to go in an emergency.

Mr. Thomas suggested finding out what the Borough's responsibility is first.

BUILDINGS & GROUNDS: Mr. Thomas said a new walk in door with a key pad is needed for the Fire Department truck room.

STREETS & SANITATION: Mr. Yarnell presented the Foreman's report for May. He said he checked with PennDOT and to designate an alley as a street it must have a 16 foot right-of-way and a 16 foot cartway. He also said the Sewage Authority was contacted about the sinking manhole on Sheridan Avenue near the school.

FIRE & WATER: Fire Chief's report for May: 42 alarms and drills. Truck mileage: 41 miles on the 1994 rescue truck, 160 miles on the 2008 engine, 56 miles on the 2004 squad truck and

902 miles on the chief's vehicle.

PARKS & RECREATION: Mr. Hixson reported that the Summer Program began last week.

PLANNING, ZONING & CODE ENFORCEMENT: Zoning Officer's Report for May: 2 building permits, 1 accessory building permit, 1 swimming pool permit and 1 zoning certification for a total of \$105.00. UCC Report for May: no permits issued.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT: No report.

ENGINEER'S REPORT: Mr. Regola said he has reviewed the stormwater management plan for Dr. Dennis Kreinbrook. He said additional property is needed for the third building, which would also require a zoning change.

SEWAGE AUTHORITY REPORT: Mr. Roman said the Sewage Authority is still under a tap restriction due to lack of an agreement with Hempfield.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Mr. Kunkle presented the financial report for May. A motion was made by Hixson/Iezzi to acknowledge receipt of the financial report.

VOTE: 5 Yes, 0 No, 2 Not Present, 0 Abstain - Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

A. **AMEND C-1 ZONING FOR LIVE ENTERTAINMENT:** Tabled until response is received from the Planning Commission.

B. **ZONING CHANGE TO C-2 FOR BROAD STREET EXTENSION:** Tabled until response is received from the Planning Commission.

NEW BUSINESS:

A. **WINTER SNOW REMOVAL AGREEMENT WITH PENNDOT:** A motion was made by Yarnell/Thomas to approve the 2012-2013 Winter Snow Removal Agreement with PennDOT.

VOTE: 5 Yes, 0 No, 2 Not Present, 0 Abstain - Motion carried.

B. **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION SPONSORSHIP:** A motion was made by Yarnell/Iezzi to sponsor the Household Hazardous Waste Collection to be held at Westmoreland County Community College on October 6, 2012 at a cost of \$40.00.

VOTE: 5 Yes, 0 No, 2 Not Present, 0 Abstain - Motion carried.

C. **CUSTODIAN WAGES:** A motion was made by Thomas/Yarnell increase the custodian's wages to \$8.25 per hour, effective June 4, 2012.

VOTE: 5 Yes, 0 No, 2 Not Present, 0 Abstain - Motion carried.

D. **GROUNDSKEEPER:** A motion was made by Thomas/Yarnell to hire George Yurcevich Jr. as groundskeeper at \$9.75 per hour.

VOTE: 5 Yes, 0 No, 2 Not Present, 0 Abstain - Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF PURCHASES: None.

APPROVAL OF BUDGET TRANSFERS: None.

APPROVAL OF BILLS: A motion was made by Thomas/Hixson to authorize payment of the list of bills as presented by the Borough Secretary and summarized below:
