

**BOROUGH OF SOUTH GREENSBURG
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 10, 2013**

Council President Clentin Martin called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

All those present repeated the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

BIDS:

A. SALE OF RED DUMP TRUCK: Bids for the sale of the 2001 Ford Dump Truck with plow and spreader were received as follows:

A motion was made by Yarnell/Thomas to award the bid for the sale of the 2001 Ford Dump Truck with plow and spreader to Christian Layman Corps in the amount of \$7,150.00.

CITIZEN'S REMARKS:

Eric Hardy, 1438 Elm Street

Mr. Hardy said he started to repair his sidewalks and it will take him some time to finish. He said there are other sidewalks and curbs in town that need repaired too. He also thanked Council for the use of Hirst Hall for training classes for firemen. There were two graduates from the classes who are members of our Fire Department.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES: A motion was made by Iezzi/Putt to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on May 13, 2013.

CORRESPONDENCE: The Borough Secretary read monthly correspondence and copies were given to each Council member.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

MAYOR: Mayor Dobies presented the Police Report for May: 165 incidents, 89 citations, 6 parking notices, 6 arrests, 1,956 miles logged on the cars and \$3,169.52 collected in fines and reports. Permit Report: 3 garage sale permits, 1 peddler's permit and 4 solid waste disposal permits for a total of \$155.00

POLICE & EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT: Mrs. Iezzi reported that the Click-it-or-Ticket program ended on June 9, 2013. She also suggested Council consider an Ordinance regulating methadone clinics.

BUILDINGS & GROUNDS: Mr. Thomas said a group of volunteers will begin work on the Fire Department truck apron on June 22, 2013 by removing the old concrete. He also said the outside camera for the Police Department is getting repaired.

STREETS & SANITATION: Mr. Yarnell presented the Foreman's report for May. He said Terry ordered some new street signs. He also said the Teamsters sent a letter about negotiations for the new contract.

FIRE & WATER: Dr. Zalakar presented the Fire Chief's report for May: 25 alarms and drills. Truck mileage: 25 miles on the 1994 rescue truck, 139 miles on the 2008 engine, 117 miles on the 2004 squad truck and 1053 miles on the chief's vehicle.

PARKS & RECREATION: Mr. Hixson reported the Summer Program activities will begin on June 17, 2013. He said the opening on the Recreation Board will be advertised on the Borough website. He also said repairs are needed to the Kelley Park storage area because of flooding. He also requested handicapped signs for the Fall midget football season.

PLANNING, ZONING & CODE ENFORCEMENT: Mrs. Putt presented the Zoning Officer's report for May: 1 building permit, 2 sign permits, 1 accessory building permit, 3 fence permits and 1 zoning certification for a total of \$130.00. UCC Report for May: no permits issued.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT: Mr. Fedele said he talked to the forester and he is re-doing the agreement and will send it to the Borough.

ENGINEER'S REPORT: No report.

SEWAGE AUTHORITY REPORT: Mr. Petroy reported that PennDOT will be paving Pittsburgh Street from Main Street up to the bypass. He also said that plant repairs should be done by the end of August.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Mr. Kunkle presented the financial report for May. A motion was made by Thomas/Hixson to acknowledge receipt of the financial report.

VOTE: 7 Yes, 0 No, 0 Not Present, 0 Abstain - Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

NEW BUSINESS:

A. GROUNDSKEEPER: A motion was made by Thomas/Putt to hire Wayne Piscar as Groundskeeper at \$9.75 per hour.

B. BLATNIK-KREINBROOK SUBDIVISION: A motion was made by Iezzi/Putt to approve the Blatnik-Kreinbrook subdivision.

C. RECREATION DIRECTOR: A motion was made by Hixson/Iezzi to hire Rachel Roddy as Recreation Director at a salary of \$410.00 per week for 8 weeks.

D. PLAYGROUND LEADER: A motion was made by Hixson/Iezzi to hire Anthony Monstrola as Playground Leader at a salary of \$375.00 per week for 8 weeks.

E. HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION: A motion was made by Thomas/Putt to sponsor the Household Hazardous Waste Collection to be held at Westmoreland County Community College on Saturday, October 5, 2013 at a cost of \$80.00.

F. AGREEMENT WITH EHRLICH: A motion was made by Yarnell/Iezzi to approve the agreement with Ehrlich to spray the vegetation along Jacks Run at a cost of \$1,552.00.
