

**BOROUGH OF SOUTH GREENSBURG
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
MARCH 11, 2013**

Council President Clentin Martin called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

All those present repeated the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

A. SALE OF BOX SPREADER: No bids received.

CITIZEN'S REMARKS:

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES: A motion was made by Thomas/Iezzi to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on February 11, 2013.

CORRESPONDENCE: The Borough Secretary read monthly correspondence and copies were given to each Council member.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

MAYOR: Mayor Dobies presented the Police Report for February: 124 incidents, 46 citations, 2 parking notices, 14 arrests, 1930 miles logged on the cars and \$3,501.37 collected in fines and reports.

POLICE & EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT: No report.

BUILDINGS & GROUNDS: Mr. Thomas reported that a lighting study will be done in the Municipal Building and Maintenance Building to determine if we qualify for a rebate program for new lighting. He said rebates could be from 25% to 100%. He also reported that water lines in the Recreation Building broke because the water wasn't turned off.

STREETS & SANITATION: Mr. Yarnell presented the Foreman's report for February. Mr. Yarnell also reported that all trucks are operating okay.

FIRE & WATER: Dr. Zalakar presented the Fire Chief's report for February: 43 alarms and drills. Truck mileage: 109 miles on the 1994 rescue truck, 158 miles on the 2008 engine, 29 miles on the 2004 squad truck and 300 miles on the chief's vehicle.

PARKS & RECREATION: Mr. Hixson reported baseball and softball practices are beginning.

PLANNING, ZONING & CODE ENFORCEMENT: Mrs. Putt reported there were no permits issued for February. UCC Report for February: no permits issued.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT: No report.

ENGINEER'S REPORT: No report.

SEWAGE AUTHORITY REPORT: No report.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Mr. Kunkle presented the financial report for February. A motion was made by Iezzi/Thomas to acknowledge receipt of the financial report.
